Macmillan Nurses

Macmillan Nurses address the all-round needs of people living with cancer. It costs £34 to fund a Macmillan Nurse for an hour,

£1075 could fund a Macmillan Nurse for almost 32 hours, giving expert medical, emotional and practical support, as well as signposting to other services.



Macmillan Grants

Macmillan Grants help people with cancer on low incomes, which could cover a wide range of practical needs. This can include things such as heating bills, extra clothing, or a much-needed break.

£1075 could fund almost 4 Macmillan grants, improving the quality of life for people affected by cancer.



Support Line Services

The Macmillan Support Line team are on hand to answer questions about cancer types and treatments, provide practical and financial support, or just listen if someone needs to talk.

£1075 could pay for our Support Line Services for over 2 hours to deal with more than 48 telephone calls or web enquiries.

THE FUTURE

Every two minutes, someone in the UK is diagnosed with cancer. There are now more than 3million people living with cancer in the UK and this is set to rise to 4million by 2030.
