Payment Terms

Termly Payments

Fees paid per term are due no later than the first day of commencement of that term.

Annual Payments

To qualify for the annual discount, fees must have cleared the bank by no later than Monday 2nd September 2024 (only applicable for a full academic year - September to July). **The discount has been reflected in the figures above.**

Monthly Payments

Payment is made via Direct Debit over 10 months (September to June) and includes a 3% charge, which represents the cost incurred by the school. This has been reflected in the figures above.

There is a reduction in fees of 5% for a 2nd child. Details of any further family discounts beyond the 2nd child are available on request directly from the Finance Department.

Parents are reminded that they have signed an agreement to give a full term's notice to the Head Teacher, in writing, of the withdrawal of a pupil from the school or to pay a term's fees in lieu of notice.

Fees will not be refunded or waived for absence through sickness, if term dates are altered or if a student is released for study leave or after public examination end.

Fees for transport, music tuition and examination fees will be billed separately.

If fees are not paid by the due date we will add an additional 2% above base rate per month thereafter.
